Configuring and Viewing Statements & Invoices

The Logger's Edge has a few handy tips for both navigating through pay statements and invoices, and also some handy options for configuring statements and even emailing them. Step Rates

Step Rates are rates that you can use if the traditional rate options won't work for a certain pay scenario. One of our step rates uses a rate matrix where payment is based on distance ranges, with rates expressed as \$ per ton. For instance, a 10-mile trip pays \$4 per ton, 11 miles pays \$4.10 per ton, and 12 miles pays \$4.14 per ton, allowing for precise adjustments based on distance.

We also can build custom step rates for users when needed. If your rate structure involves some type of rule-based logic (e.g., an employee is paid so much per ton or tonne, and also a bonus of \$x per load if they exceed y loads per week), it is possible that we may be able to automate the rule through a custom step rate specifically for you. Not all rules lend themselves to the step rate structure, but if you would like to discuss the possibilities, send us an email with an explanation of your rule, and we can schedule a time to discuss.
