System Sluggishness?

Is your Logger's Edge or Cutting Edge running slower than expected? Low RAM, background bloatware like Teams or OneDrive, or cluttered Temp/Download folders can all play a role. Cleaning these up, disabling unused startup apps, running disk optimization, and checking for malware are often quick wins.

For larger databases, though, the most effective long-term solution is archiving. This process preserves data that under the criteria you specify, while moving out older transactions you no longer need day-to-day. By reducing database size, archiving can significantly boost performance, make routine tasks faster, and help ensure that Logger's Edge continues to run smoothly. Date for Pay

Sometimes loggers hand in late tickets. Or sometimes you receive tickets from one mill that you want to import and pay for a certain set of delivery dates, but another mill may send you a separate file for import for a different but partially overlapping set of date. That's where the Date for Pay comes in. This option lets you keep the true haul dates for reporting and for rate matching, while shifting the pay date to the period you actually want to process pay in.

Security & Tracking In LE

Require Login – By default, Logger's Edge can be opened by anyone on a licensed computer. With the "Require Login" option, you can add an extra layer of security. Each user must log in with their own ID and password before accessing the program, protecting sensitive information such as pricing and contracts.

Security on Posting – Mistakes happen, but reversing loads or un-posting statements are sensitive actions. With Security on Posting enabled, only Super Admin users have the authority to perform these functions. This ensures that financial records remain accurate and prevents unintended changes from slipping through.

New Upcoming Features

There will be features to come to simplify tract and rate management in version 5.3.8. You will be able to outline tracts with latitude/longitude coordinates on a map, void rates so they're fully ignored, and view a history of rate edits with timestamps. To protect accuracy, rates tied to posted statements are locked down with only End Date changes allowed. Plus, color coding will be added, which makes it easier to spot activity—orange for calculator use and grey for posted statement use. These are just a few of many updates to come; stay tuned!
